

WINTER-PROOF YOUR CAPE MAY COUNTY HOME:

HVAC & PLUMBING CHECKLIST FOR SNOWBIRDS

Leaving for the winter? Don't leave your home at risk. Use this simple checklist to protect your plumbing and HVAC systems before you head south.

BEFORE YOU GO HVAC CHECKLIST:	
	Adjust Your Thermostat Set your thermostat to 55–60°F to prevent freezing pipes and save on energy costs.
	Schedule a System Check Have your heating system inspected to ensure it's ready to run safely and efficiently while you're away.
	Change Your Air Filter A clean filter keeps your system running smoothly and prevents breakdowns.
	Install a Smart Thermostat (optional but highly recommended) Control your HVAC system remotely and get alerts if temperatures drop unexpectedly.
	Seal Drafts Check for leaks around windows and doors to keep cold air out and prevent overworking your system

BEFORE YOU GO PLUMBING CHECKLIST:

Ш	Shut Off Your Water Supply Prevent major leaks and burst pipes by turning off the main water line before leaving.
	Drain Your Pipes (if water is shut off) Flush toilets, open faucets, and drain any standing water in your lines to avoid freezing.
	Add RV Antifreeze to Drains (optional) Pour antifreeze into toilets and sink traps to prevent freezing in unheated spaces.
	Check Your Sump Pump If you have a sump pump, make sure it's working in case of unexpected rain or snowmelt.
	Install a Leak Detector Smart water sensors to alert you to leaks or pipe bursts (even when you're 1,000 miles away).
